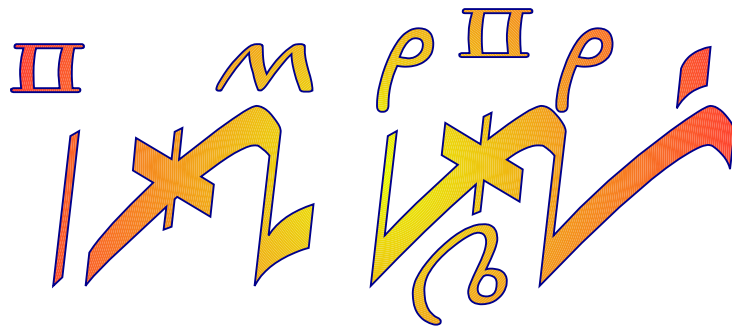

The new Unicode block Znamenny Musical Notation (1CF00..1CFCF) and the Kievan Notation section (1D1DE..1D1E8) of the Musical Symbols block are available in Symbola. The Slavonic font adds a wide range of OpenType features to both notational systems.

There are 12 alternates of each sign placed on a staff, allowing the composition of musical text.

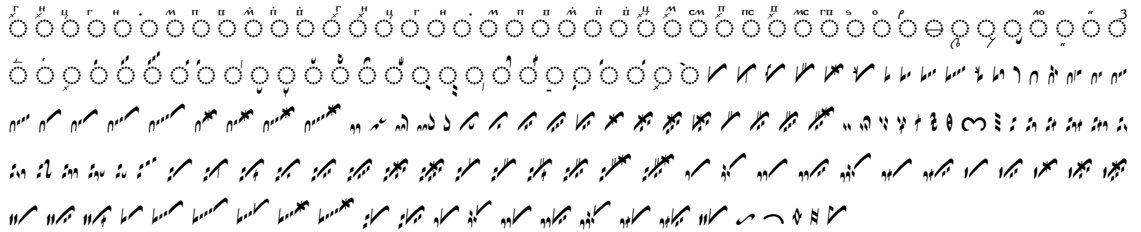
